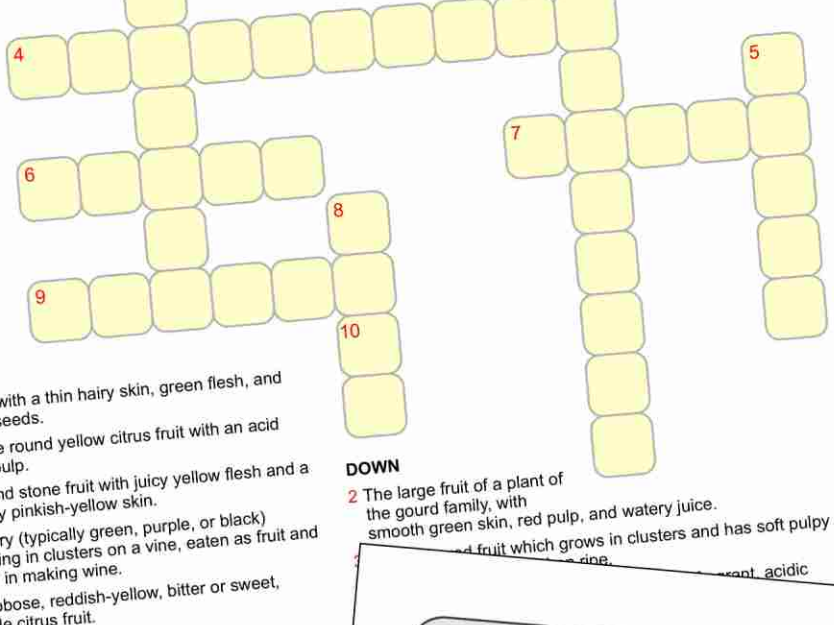

Fruit



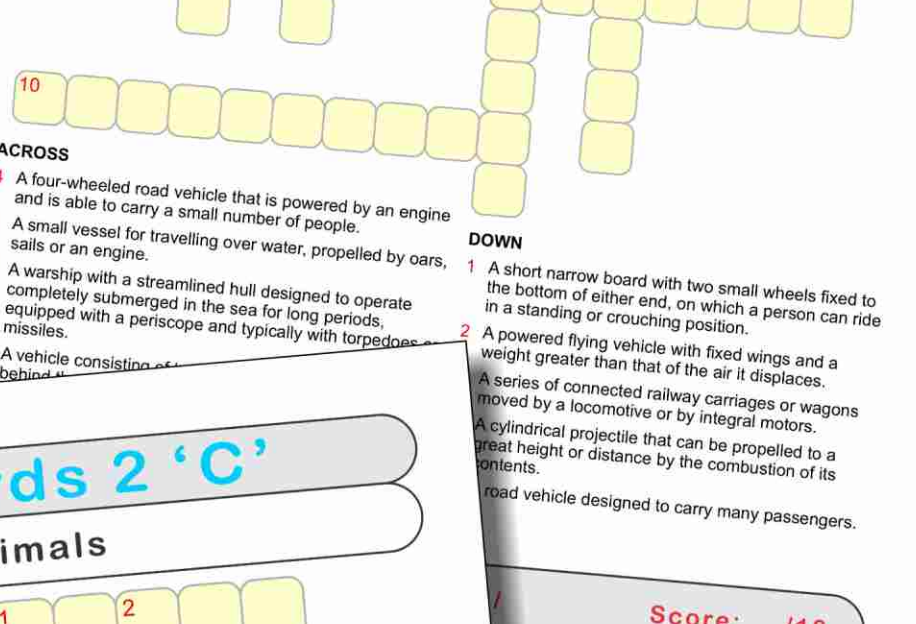
- ACROSS**
- A fruit with a thin hairy skin, green flesh, and black seeds.
 - A large round yellow citrus fruit with an acid juicy pulp.
 - A round stone fruit with juicy yellow flesh and a downy pinkish-yellow skin.
 - A berry (typically green, purple, or black) growing in clusters on a vine, eaten as fruit and used in making wine.
 - A globe, reddish-yellow, bitter or sweet, edible citrus fruit.

- DOWN**
- The large fruit of a plant of the gourd family, with completely smooth green skin, red pulp, and watery juice.
 - A fruit which grows in clusters and has soft pulp.

Transport



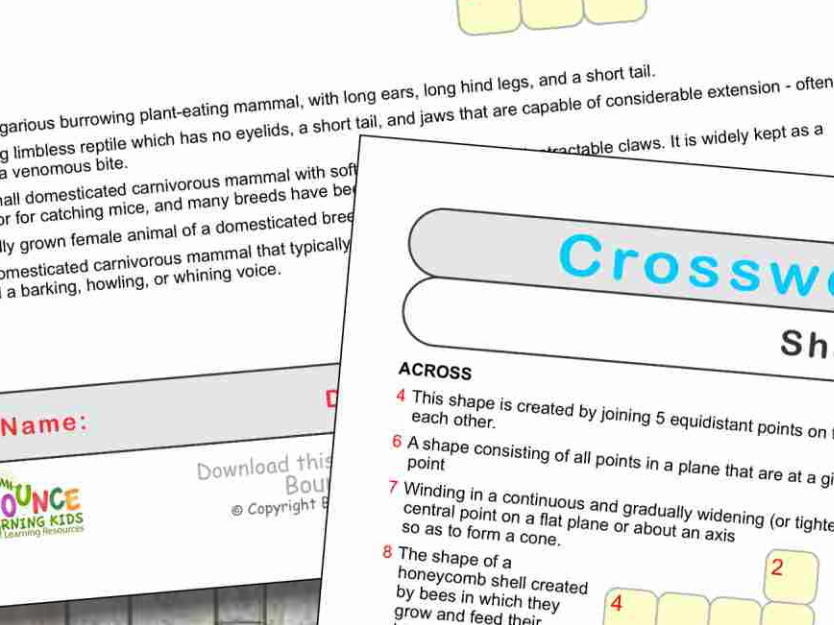
- ACROSS**
- A four-wheeled road vehicle that is powered by an engine and is able to carry a small number of people.
 - A small vessel for travelling over water, propelled by oars.
 - A warship with a streamlined hull designed to operate completely submerged in the sea for long periods.
 - A vehicle consisting of a series of connected railway carriages or wagons moved by a locomotive or by integral motors.

- DOWN**
- A short narrow board with two small wheels fixed to the bottom of either end, on which a person can ride in a standing or crouching position.
 - A powered flying vehicle with fixed wings and a weight greater than that of the air it displaces.

Farm animals



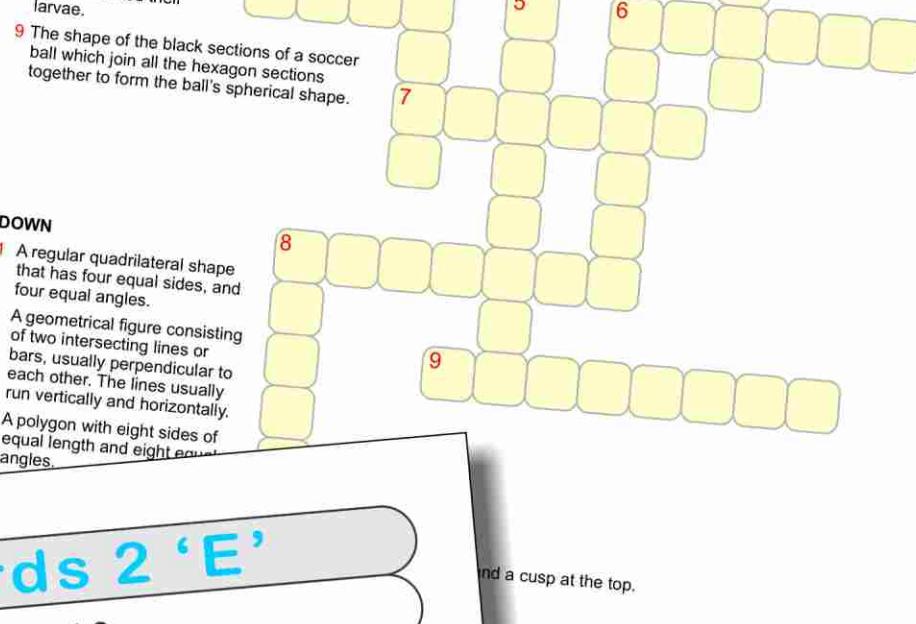
- ACROSS**
- A large plant-eating domesticated mammal with solid hoofs and a flowing mane and tail, used for riding, racing, and to carry and pull loads.
 - A domestic fowl kept for its eggs or meat, especially a young one.
 - A kind of various hollow-horned ruminant mammals (especially of the genus Capra) related to the sheep but of lighter build and with backwardly arching horns, a short tail, and usually straight hair.
 - A waterbird with a broad blunt bill, short legs, webbed feet, and a waddling gait.
 - An omnivorous domesticated hoofed mammal with sparse bristly hair and a flat snout for rooting in the soil, kept for its meat.

- DOWN**
- A gregarious burrowing plant-eating mammal, with long ears, long hind legs, and a short tail.
 - A long limbless reptile which has no eyelids, a short tail, and jaws that are capable of considerable extension - often with a venous sinus.
 - A small domesticated carnivorous mammal with soft fur or for catching mice, and many breeds have been bred for different purposes.
 - A fully grown female animal of a domesticated breed.
 - A domesticated carnivorous mammal that typically has a long, pointed snout, a short tail, and a lowing or mooing voice.

Shapes



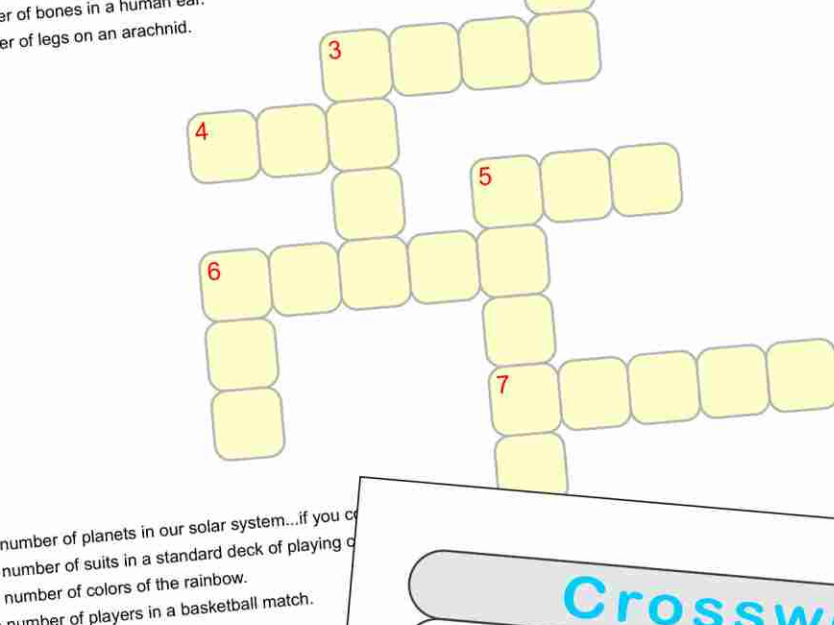
- ACROSS**
- This shape is created by joining 5 equidistant points on the outer edge of a circle to each other.
 - A shape consisting of all points in a plane that are at a given distance from a central point.
 - Winding in a continuous and gradually widening (or tightening) curve, either round so as to form a cone.
 - The shape of a honeycomb cell created by bees in which they grow and feed their larvae.
 - The shape of the black sections of a soccer ball which join all the hexagon sections together to form the ball's spherical shape.

- DOWN**
- A regular quadrilateral shape that has four equal sides, and four equal angles.
 - A geometrical figure consisting of two intersecting lines at each other. The lines usually intersect vertically and horizontally.
 - A polygon with eight sides of equal length and eight equal angles.

Numbers 1-10



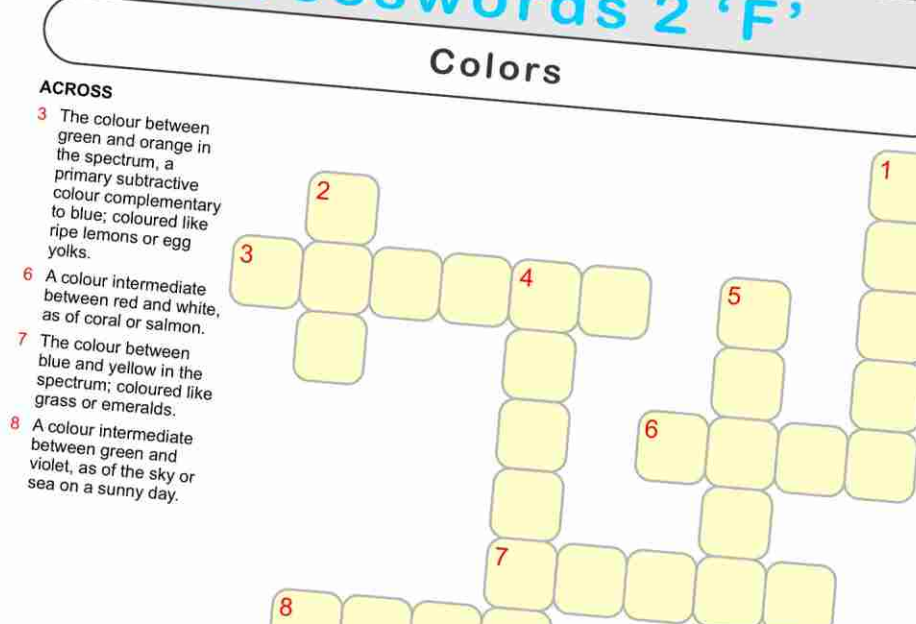
- ACROSS**
- Exactly half of two.
 - The Roman numeral for this number is V.
 - A stringed musical instrument, with a fretted fingerboard, typically incurved sides, and six or twelve strings, played by plucking or strumming with the fingers.
 - A percussion instrument sounded by being struck with sticks or the hands, typically cylindrical, barrel-shaped, or bowl-shaped, with a taut membrane over one or both ends.
 - A large keyboard musical instrument with a wooden case enclosing a soundboard and metal strings, which are struck by hammers when the keys are depressed.
 - A large brass wind instrument with straight tubing in three sections, ending in a bell over the player's left shoulder; different fundamental notes being made using a forward-pointing extendable slide.

Colors



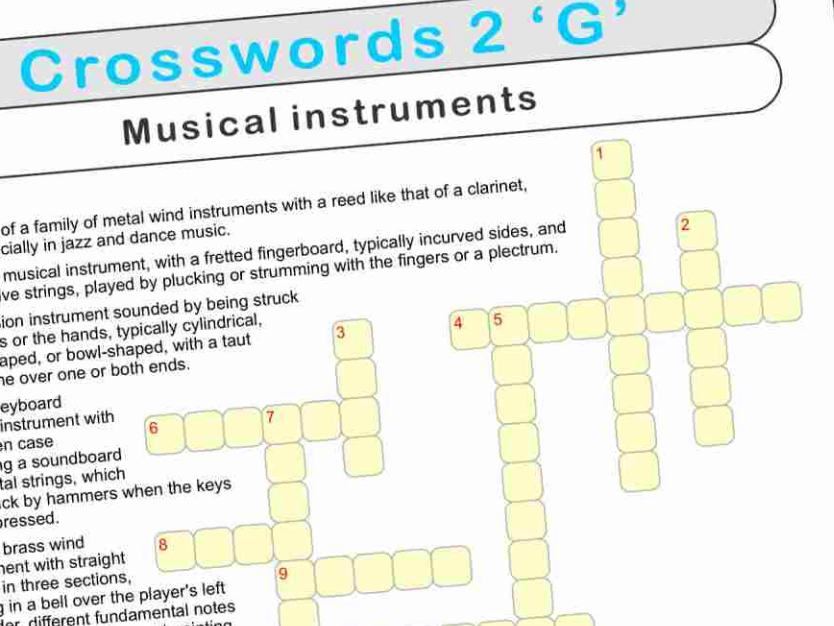
- ACROSS**
- The colour between green and orange in the spectrum, a primary subtractive colour complementary to blue; coloured like ripe lemons or egg yolks.
 - A colour intermediate between red and white, as of coral and salmon.
 - The colour between blue and yellow in the spectrum; coloured like grass or emeralds.
 - A colour intermediate between green and violet, as of the sky or sea on a sunny day.

- DOWN**
- The very darkest colour owing to the absence of reflection of light; the opposite of white.
 - A colour at the end of the spectrum, the opposite of red.
 - A colour that is the opposite of black.

Musical instruments



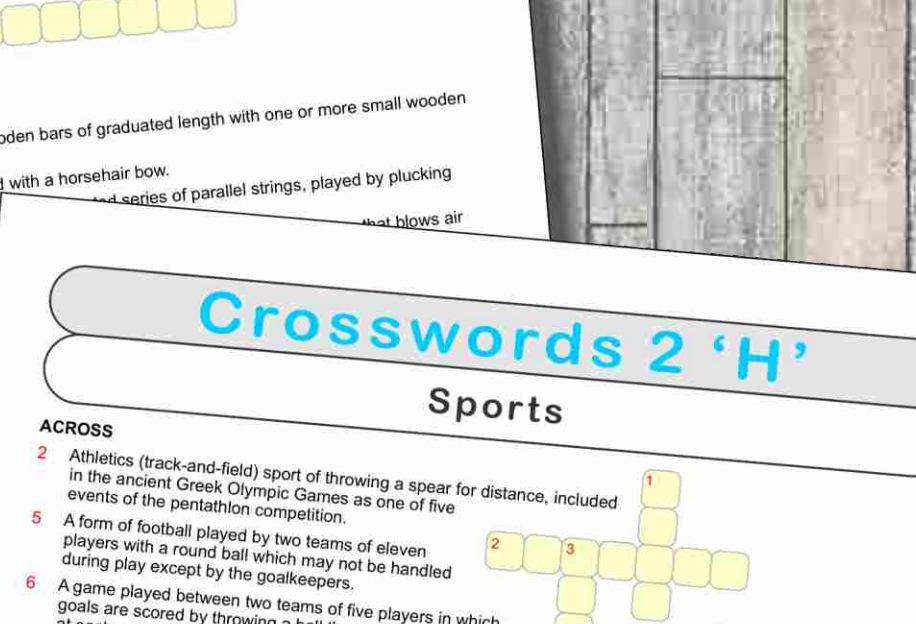
- ACROSS**
- A member of a family of metal wind instruments with a reed like that of a clarinet.
 - A stringed musical instrument, with a fretted fingerboard, typically incurved sides, and six or twelve strings, played by plucking or strumming with the fingers.
 - A percussion instrument sounded by being struck with sticks or the hands, typically cylindrical, barrel-shaped, or bowl-shaped, with a taut membrane over one or both ends.
 - A large keyboard musical instrument with a wooden case enclosing a soundboard and metal strings, which are struck by hammers when the keys are depressed.
 - A large brass wind instrument with straight tubing in three sections, ending in a bell over the player's left shoulder; different fundamental notes being made using a forward-pointing extendable slide.

- A musical instrument played by striking a row of wooden bars of graduated length with one or more small wooden mallets.
 - A stringed musical instrument of treble pitch, played with a horsehair bow.
 - A stringed instrument consisting of a frame support with a wooden case and strings.
 - A musical instrument played by stretching and snapping over metal reeds, the melody and chords being struck by the fingers.
 - A brass musical instrument with a flared bell and a looped to form a straight-sided coil, with three valves.

Sports



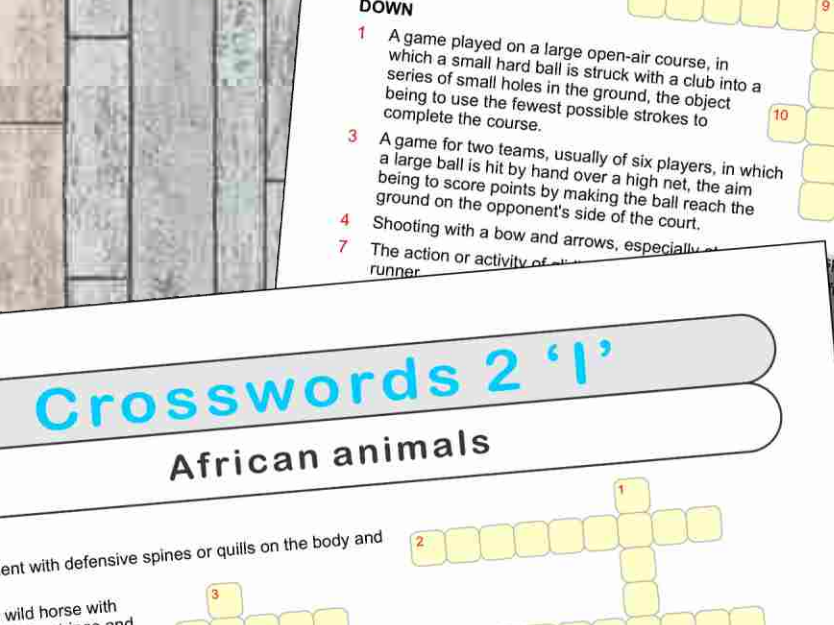
- ACROSS**
- Athletics (track-and-field) sport of throwing a spear for distance, included in the ancient Greek Olympic Games as one of five events of the pentathlon.
 - A form of football played by two teams of eleven players with a round ball which may not be handled during play except by the goalkeepers.
 - A game played between two teams of five players in which goals are scored by throwing a ball through a netted hoop fixed over a net stretched across a court. The usual form is played on a grass, clay, or artificial surface.
 - The action of travelling over snow on long, narrow pieces of hard, flexible material, typically pointed and turned up at the front, fastened under the feet.

- DOWN**
- A game played on a large open-air course, in which a small hard ball is struck with a club into a being to use the fewest possible strokes to complete the course.
 - A game for two teams, usually of six players, in which a large ball is hit by hand over a high net, the aim being to score points by making the ball reach the ground on the opponent's side of the court.
 - The action or activity of running.

African animals



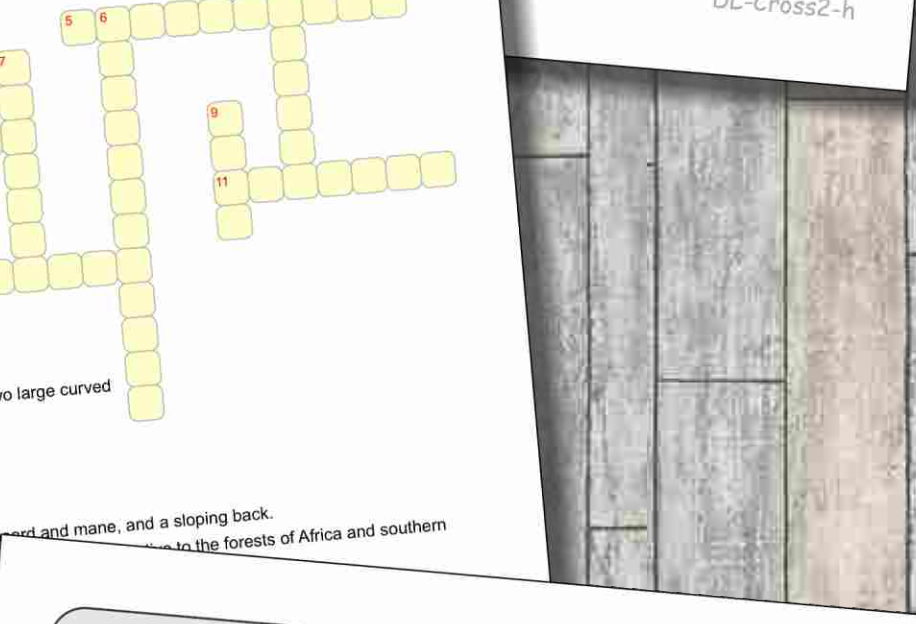
- ACROSS**
- A large rodent with defensive spines or quills on the body and a long tail.
 - An African wild horse with black-and-white stripes and an erect mane.
 - A large, heavily built plant-eating mammal with one or two horns on the nose and thick folded skin, native to Africa and southern Asia. All kinds have become endangered through hunting.
 - A large African mammal with a very long neck and forelegs, having a coat patterned with brown patches separated by lighter lines. It is the tallest living animal.
 - A flightless swift-running African bird with a long neck, long legs, and two toes on each foot. It is the largest living bird, with males reaching a height of up to 2.75 m.
 - A doglike African mammal with a long trunk and two large curved tusks.

- DOWN**
- A large dark African antelope with a long head, a beard and mane, and a sloping back.
 - A large solitary cat that has a tawny or brown coat.
 - A large thick-skinned semiaquatic African mammal.
 - A large slender spotted cat found in Africa and parts of Asia.
 - A large tawny-coloured cat that lives in prides, with shaggy mane and takes little part in hunting.
 - A doglike African mammal with forelimbs that are shorter than its hind limbs, used for scavenging but most are effective hunters.

Tools



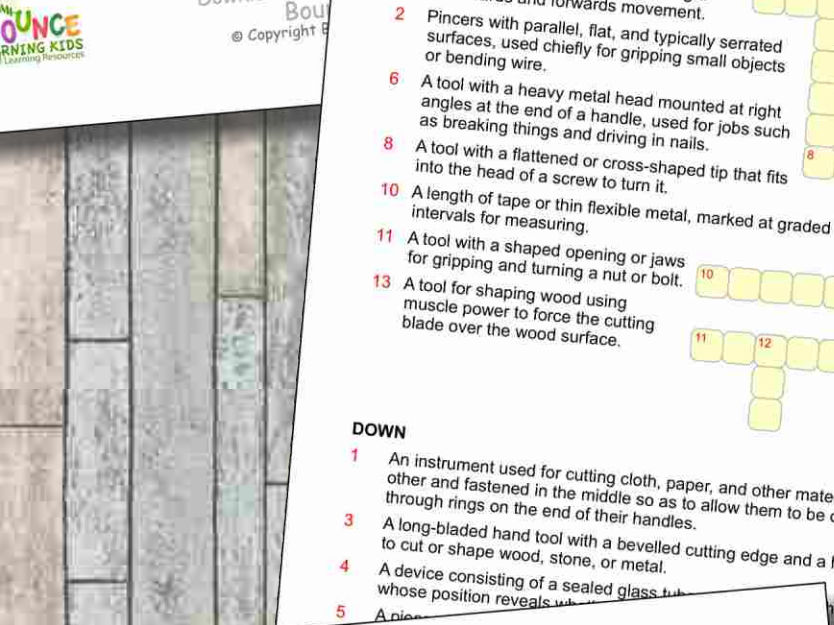
- ACROSS**
- A hand tool for cutting wood or other hard materials, typically with a long, thin serrated blade and operated using a back-and-forth motion.
 - A tool with parallel, flat, and typically serrated surfaces, used chiefly for gripping small objects or bending wire.
 - A tool with a heavy metal head mounted at right angles at the end of a handle, used for jobs such as breaking things and driving in nails.
 - A tool with a flattened or cross-shaped tip that fits into the head of a screw to turn it.
 - A length of tape or thin flexible metal, marked at graded intervals for measuring.
 - A tool with a shaped opening or jaws for gripping and turning a nut or bolt.
 - A tool for shaping wood using motor power to force the cutting blade over the wood surface.

- DOWN**
- An instrument used for cutting cloth, paper, and other material, consisting of two blades laid one on top of the other and fastened in the middle so as to allow them to be opened and closed by a thumb and finger inserted at the end of their handles.
 - A long-bladed hand tool with a bevelled cutting edge and a handle which is struck with a hammer or mallet, whose position reveals the position of the object being cut.
 - A liquid, usually alcohol or other liquid, containing an air bubble between two upright lengths of wood, metal, or rope, used for cutting or as a weapon.
 - A tool used for making holes in wood and other materials.

Countries



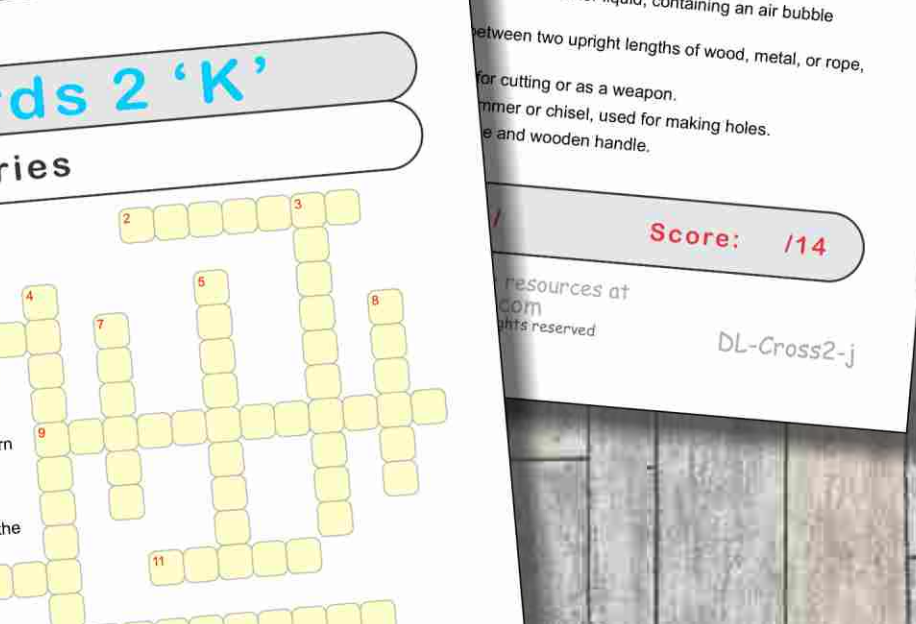
- ACROSS**
- The largest division of the United Kingdom, consisting with Scotland and Wales, the island of Great Britain.
 - An island country in East Asia, located in the northwest Pacific Ocean. It is bordered on the west by the Sea of Okhotsk in Japan, and extends from the Sea of Okhotsk in the north toward the East China Sea and Taiwan in the south.
 - An island and special territory of Chile in the southeastern Pacific Ocean, at the southernmost point of the Polynesian Triangle in Oceania.
 - A country in South Asia. It is the second-most populous country, the seventh-largest country by land area, and the most populous southern European country.
 - A peninsula of the Mediterranean Sea projecting into the Adriatic Sea, between the Tyrrhenian and Ionian Seas.
 - A country in northwestern Europe, known for a flat landscape of canals, tulip fields, windmills and cycling routes.

- DOWN**
- A transcontinental country spanning the northeast corner of Africa and southwest corner of Asia by a land bridge formed by the Sinai Peninsula.
 - An island country in the southwestern Pacific Ocean. It consists of two main landmasses—the North Island and the South Island—and more than 700 smaller islands, covering a total area of 268,021 square kilometres.
 - A country of 50 states covering a vast swath of North America.
 - A sovereign country comprising the mainland of the nation's presence into the Pacific Ocean.
 - A sovereign country comprising the mainland of the nation's presence into the Pacific Ocean.
 - A transcontinental country spanning Eastern Europe and Western Asia.
 - A republic in W. Europe, between the English Channel and the Atlantic Ocean.

Space



- ACROSS**
- Fourth planet from the Sun and the second-smallest planet in the Solar System, being larger than only Mercury.
 - The fifth planet from the Sun and the largest in the Solar System. It is a gas giant with a mass one-thousandth that of the Sun, but two and a half times that of all the other planets in the Solar System combined.
 - A modular habitable artificial satellite in low Earth orbit. It is a multinational collaborative project involving five participating space agencies.
 - The sixth planet from the Sun and the second-largest in the Solar System, after Jupiter. It is a gas giant with an average radius of about nine times that of Earth. It only has one-eighth the average density of Earth, but its volume is over 85 times more massive.
 - The second planet from the Sun. It is named after the Roman goddess of love and beauty. As the brightest natural object in Earth's night sky after the Moon, it can cast shadows and can be, on rare occasions, visible to the naked eye.
 - Earth's only proper natural satellite. At one-quarter the diameter of Earth, it is the largest natural satellite in the Solar System relative to the size of its planet, and the fifth largest satellite in the Solar System overall.

- DOWN**
- The seventh planet from the Sun. Its name is a reference to the Greek god of the sky, and its largest planetary mass in the Solar System.
 - A dwarf planet in the Kuiper belt, a ring of bodies beyond the orbit of Neptune. It was the first and the largest known dwarf planet in the Solar System. Its orbit around the Sun takes 87.97 Earth days, and it is the fourth-largest planet by diameter in the Solar System.
 - A sphere of hot plasma, heated to incandescence by its own internal energy and heated by visible light and infrared radiation.
 - A small celestial body that orbits around the Sun and is much smaller than a planet.
