This 36-card deck is all about learning how to read and understand the information presented in a table. It is a slightly more complex and challenging version of Tables #1

There are 6 different tables in this deck, each with a range of questions associated with it. As the decks progress, the tables become slightly more complicated, with more rows, columns, levels of difficulty in the questions, etc.

There are 2 types of questions presented for each series of tables. Some are multiple choice whilst others are fill-in-the-blank, where a numeric answer is required. On some cards, there's a mixture of both.

Learning to read and understand tables provides an excellent foundation for learning to read and understand spreadsheets.
